What is Open Farm Days?

- Alberta Open Farm Days is a province-wide event inviting Albertans to learn about and experience rural life.
 - Saturday: a series of culinary events around the province
 - Sunday: a province wide open house of participating farms
- Visitors are treated to authentic and educational rural experiences.
 - A backstage pass for visitors to see farms firsthand and meet the farmers
 - An opportunity to learn where food come from and how it is produced

Where It All Began

- Started in 2001 in New Brunswick by the Agricultural Alliance of New Brunswick
- Since 2001 several other provinces have joined in
